Ramadan begins this week. Please see the message below. Eid Mubarak to all of you who will be celebrating Eid in April.

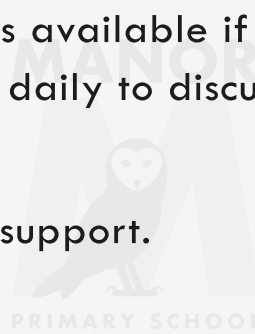

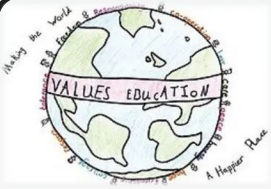
The Senior leaders are always available if you wish to speak to us and Mrs Khanom is also available daily to discuss any safeguarding or family concerns.

RAMADAN MUBARAK

This year, Ramadan is due to begin on the 10th/11th March 2024. As our families are already aware, Ramadan is one of the most sacred, holy months. It includes a month of fasting (sawm), where Muslims abstain from drinking (including water) or eating from dawn to sunset. In fact, the Arabic word 'sawm' means 'to refrain'.

Some of our children will be fasting at school and have expressed a desire to complete their midday prayers at school. To support the children with this, we will be allowing the children who are fasting to stay inside whilst their peers eat their lunch; they will be supervised by an adult. If your child is fasting, please ensure you send a note to the class teacher to inform them.
