

Manor Infants' School / Manor Longbridge - Sports Premium Statement 2022/23.

At Manor Infants' School / Manor Longbridge, we recognise that **ALL** children are entitled to *high-quality* Physical Education (PE) and *effective* Physical Activity (PA), as essential components that grow students physically, social, emotional and culturally. Regardless of their starting point and prior experience, every child has the right to access to a wide and varied range of high-quality opportunities and experiences. Opportunities should allow all students to acquire, develop new and extend existing skills, motivate, inspire and cultivate rounded 'physically literate students' who choose to engage and enjoy regular physical activity, knowing it to be one essential element of a healthy lifestyle.

As part of each school's budget, the government allocates a Sports Premium to help primary schools improve the quality of the PE, PA and School Sports provision they offer their pupils. This year's sports funding, for our school, is **£26,810**.

Manor Infants' School / Manor Longbridge invests the Sports Premium allocation in a way that maximises sustainable, long-term improvements to the schools PE, PA and School Sports provision for ALL students.

The areas of priority this year are:

- To ensure we continue to raise and standardise the quality of PE delivery across Manor Infants' School / Longbridge through; implementation of an effective and sustainable teacher skill development programme that focuses on upskilling, improve knowledge base and develop delivery confidence.
- To expand a sustainable offering of competitive and mass-participation sporting experiences available to all students - focus on offering a wider range of morning and after-school sporting clubs and opportunities to include gifted & talented.
- To ensure PE, PA and School Sports participation is recognised within Manor Infants / Longbridge, ensuring a sporting legacy is established and celebrated.
- To ensure every child has access to quality programme of PA and Sporting provision which is well planned and led by professionals and contributes to the peer reviewed recommendation of achieving 60 minutes moderate to high intensity physical activity each day.

1. 2. Lunchtime Play Leader	£3,080 (cost based on 2021-22 – will need to be adjusted for inflation etc.)	<p>Children have the opportunity to engage in adult lead fun, active, PA and games during their lunch break.</p> <p>Mentor to Student Sports & PA Ambassadors to maximize student ownership and development.</p> <p>This will increase participation in voluntary effective physical activity (maximizing the attainment of 60 minutes a day).</p>
3. Competition Preparation	£2,122	Children receive professional coaching and maximize the development and understanding of teamwork in preparations for a competitive environment – borough focused competitions.

4. Morning, Afterschool & Celebration Event provision expansion - Professional Sports Coaches	£7,000	Maximize the opportunities available for all students and ensures that children have access to high quality experiences which, raises the overall standard and experience of PESSPA (Physical Education, School Sport and Physical Activity) at Manor Infants / Longbridge.
5. PESSPA celebration and profile raising - equipment / boards / trophies etc	£2700	Ensure that PE, PA and Sporting activities can be delivered and celebrated to the highest standards. Develop a positive legacy which promotes the ethos of the school.

ALL students at Manor Infants' School / Manor Longbridge, are timetabled a minimum of 90 minutes of PE per week. In addition to dedicated sessions of high-quality instruction, practice and feedback, ALL students have access to a wide range of high-quality physical activity through timetabled and voluntary indoor and outdoor sessions and activities.
