Topic Work

Our topic this term is 'Bright Lights, Big City'. We will be looking at a range of London buildings and transport. We will creating a 'London Guide' for tourists in our English



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lessons. During our Art lessons we will be paying attention to detail when drawing London buildings.

In February we will be focusing on Children's Mental Health. We will be taking part in lots of fun and exciting activities! In March we will be celebrating Book Fortnight in our school.

Mathematics

In mathematics the children will be consolidating Maths and developing their knowledge of addition and subtraction facts to 20. They will also be involved in work on weight and volume, length and height, and place value (up to 50). You can find some really useful Maths lessons from White Rose from this link:
